Tasting Notes

Brick red in colour. There is an aromatic intensity that is bursting with black cherries, plums, cinnamon and clove. The flavours continue in the same vein with dark skinned fruits, Christmas cake, hints of toffee, liquorice and star anise, with a round, luscious mouth-feel.
