Background

Skuttlebutt: The antiquated nautical term for the source of water on sea going vessels has the derived meaning of slang, gossip, chitta chatta, rumour etc. The site of this life-sustaining liquid on board was also the bed from which the grapevine of social gossip did sprout. As such, the chance to catch up with friends over a glass of good wine is the perfect occasion for Skuttlebutt.

Tasting Notes

Lifted aromatics of grapefruit and lime are supported with beautiful floral notes, subtle passionfruit and a lavender perfume. On the palate ripe peaches and pears from the semillon are complemented by preserved lemon, finishing with great volume and a delicious fruit sweetness.
